Thanks for your email.

As discussed on the phone this morning, CASA has agreed to continue to process the request with the amended scope of:

The report, the findings and conclusions, closure letter and correspondence to and from ICAO on the matter of wind turbines (in relation to the report).

As noted in my letter to you of 8 November 2012, the time taken during the request consultation process with you is not taken into account for the purposes of the 30 day time limit for processing your request.

The time limit resumes from tomorrow, 14 November 2012, with 10 days remaining. As discussed today, we will need to consult with a third party and the timeframe will be extended to complete this process.
